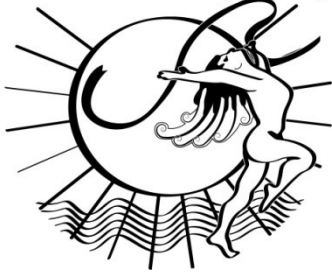

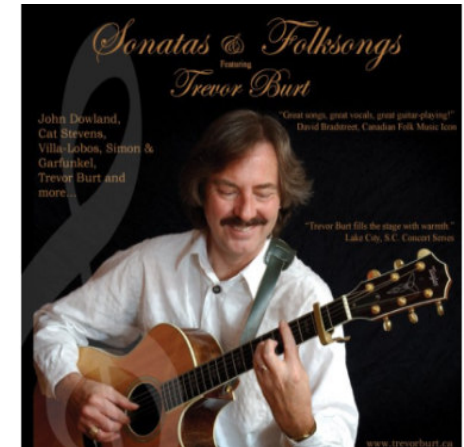

Trevor Burt

Sonatas & Folksongs



Trevor Burt has created a highly original style that combines elements from the classical music idiom with those of contemporary folk music. The result is a body of works both timeless and unique

Whether playing folk clubs like Egertons in Toronto during the mid-seventies or performing a classical guitar recital at Meredith College in Raleigh, North Carolina over a decade later, Trevor has presented music that bridges the gulf between these seemingly disparate styles. "I have always tried to incorporate both idioms into my repertoire. I'd play Bach's Jesu, Joy of Man's Desiring between songs by John Prine and Bruce Cockburn back in the day", Trevor explains. "More recently", he resumes, "I've been performing my own Variations on Gordon Lightfoot's Pussy Willows, Cattails in solo classical guitar recitals".
